John Alleyne's *Streetcar* combines compelling dance with superb acting, lavish costumes, and an original jazz score by Canadian composer Tobin Stokes. Transport yourself to New Orleans for a night of intrigue, sultry jazz tunes, and high-caliber dramatic flair in *A Streetcar Named Desire*.

Petrushka (2019)

Choreography: Heather Dotto Music: Igor Stravinsky, *Petrushka* Additional Music: Heather Dotto Length: 23 minutes

Heather Dotto's jovially abstract *Petrushka r*eflects on a puppet's desire to be human and is a meditation on the power of darkness and loneliness. Embodying Petrushka's original playfulness and theatricality, Dotto makes use of exaggerated gestures, miming, and a layered, up-tempo response to Stravinsky's original score to reinvigorate the work's clownish foundation.

Cuatro Estaciones is an evocative tango-inspired ensemble piece by Ballet Kelowna's visionary Artistic Director Simone Orlando set to virtuoso composer Astor Piazzolla's Four Seasons of Buenos Aires. Orlando's choreography infuses ballet's contemporary lines with the intricate, expressive elements of Argentine Tango and features the full company performing fiery steps in stunning group formations and seductive duets.

John Alleyne's Schubert displays the ethereal transience of the autumnal season, celebrating the life of a dancer in three scenes: youth, beauty, and wisdom. Set to Franz Schubert's breathtaking Trio in E Flat Major, Opus 100, this neo-classical piece conveys the rhythmic and inevitable cycle of life and is performed by Ballet Kelowna's full company of dancers.

Firebird (2019)

Choreography: Amber Funk Barton Music: Igor Stravinsky, *The Firebird* Length: 28 minutes

Amber Funk Barton's *Firebird* is a dynamic examination of heroism. Grounded in her signature street style of contemporary movement and influenced by pop culture's fascination with comic book superheroes, Barton re-awakens the century-old tale to a new destiny – one where the mighty Firebird is in control of her own future, harnessing her mystical superpowers in a selfless act of honour and bravery.



In Between (2018)

Choreography: Alysa Pires Music: Adam Sakiyama Length: 14 minutes

In Between, by rising choreographer Alysa Pires, is a reflection of Pires' own life story as a native Vancouver Islander and transplanted Torontonian. In Between is a meditation on a life divided between two places – a past intrinsically linked to body and soul, and a future that lights the way forward. Inspired by the constant churning and ebb and flow of the ocean, the work draws inspiration from nature and its powerful connection to our existence and features an original composition by Adam Sakiyama.

Eight and Sand (2017)

Eight and Sand, by Gioconda Barbuto, is an explosive ensemble piece that explores the history of the Canadian railroad through the theme of "building and journey". The term "eight and sand" is used to wish train crews a quick, uneventful trip.
